WA Regional Airports Development Scheme (RADS)

Grants now open

The Department of Transport will be providing up to \$3.5 million in grants for the 2021-23 round of successful RADS applications.

The 2021-23 RADS round includes a COVID-19 Stimulus Initiative to support Western Australia's economy as part of the COVID-19 recovery. RADS funds up to 75% of the total eligible project cost will be considered for projects supporting at least 50% of the total labour costs sourced from WA regional businesses and can be completed prior to 31 December 2021.

The 2021-23 round of Regional Airports Development Scheme grants are open for applications from July 6 and close on **August 7, 2020.**
