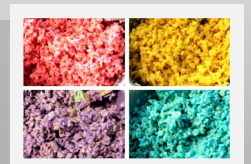

## Craft ideas for sensory play Exploring children’s sense of touch

Sensory play games like pouring and scooping are great for babies and toddlers. The weighing and measuring activity and the more complex art ideas are more suitable for children in their early years of primary school .

- **Materials/equipment**
- **Rice (as much or as little as you would like to colour)**
- **Snap lock bags**
- **Food dye & Glitter (optional)**
- **Cling wrap**



Put as much rice as you would like to colour in a snap lock bag. If you are making several different colours you will need a separate snap lock bag for each colour. Snap the bag closed and mix until the rice absorbs the colour. Add extra food dye if required.
