Evidence Based Programmes

From 1st July 2017, the DSS requires that 50 percent of WPC4C's service delivery funding to be allocated to Evidence Based Programmes (EBP).

The DSS has released an EBP Guide, which lists programmes that have been already approved as EBPs. DSS has stated that EBPs from the Guide should be delivered 'as is' with any modifications to the programme delivery discussed with the host organisation of that particular EBP and WPC4C.
