



The focus of the Chevron Pilbara Ear Health programme is Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islanders and high-risk children. Screening services have been expanded to include all children in participating primary schools and Year 7 students in high school. Each bus is fitted with equipment to enable trained screeners to perform ear health and hearing screening. The programme aims to identify children with ear health problems early so that appropriate treatment can be implemented and managed to achieve better long-term outcomes in health and education.






